

7. Biblical hermeneutics, preaching and psychological type

Since the 1990s Leslie J Francis has pioneered research-based innovation within the fields of hermeneutics and preaching. Drawing on Jungian psychological type theory he has refined the SIFT method of biblical hermeneutics and liturgical preaching.
